#### Important Information

If the date you are rostered doesn't suit you, **you** must arrange for someone to take your place. Please inform Richard Dobson of any swaps arranged between riders.

Criteriaums may be raced 3 grades at a time depending on conditions. If you want to race you will need to arrange for someone to take your place during your race – this can be arranged on the day. Riders failing to take their turn as an official will not be allowed to race until such time as they have taken their turn.

Officials are requested to arrive one hour before the start of racing – ie 1pm.

Officials may be required to perform one or more of the following; race starter, judge finish, take entries, assign numbers, set up signage, corner marshall or lead/follow car.

Corner marshalls must wear safety vests provided. Corner marshalls are allocated to control the safety of the riders at points where conflict with motorists may occur. Your judgement is not to be questioned. Position yourself with regard to your own safety, whilst still being visible to road users and riders. The red flag is used to stop the riders only.

The red flag **must not** be used to control vehicular traffic – this can only be done by the **accredited traffic controllers** (*shown in italics on the roster*).
